- ✓ Growing trade conflicts and geopolitical tensions
- ✓ Rising anti-globalisation sentiment

- ✓ <u>The rules-based, free, fair and open international economic order needs to be strengthened</u>
- ✓ Each country should undertake the necessary structural reforms

1. Digital Transformation



(1) Develop policy frameworks to utilise data

- (A) Establish the next generation data governance framework
 - ➤ Accord nondiscriminatory treatments to digital products and services, *not impose customs duties on electronic transmissions*
 - ▶ Promote <u>international interoperability of risk-based security and privacy protection standards across jurisdictions</u> so as to <u>ensure</u> <u>the free flow of data</u>, information, ideas and knowledge across borders, while respecting applicable legal frameworks for privacy, data protection, and intellectual property rights
 - Ensure the <u>independence of business decisions</u> regarding the <u>location of computing facilities</u> and <u>confidentiality of corporate</u> <u>information</u>

1. Digital Transformation



(B) Realise a WTO rule on electronic commerce

➤ We support expediting efforts to timely launch <u>WTO negotiations</u> on trade-related aspects of electronic commerce and encourage the members concerned to work in an innovative, open and inclusive manner to <u>achieve a high standard outcome</u> with the participation of as many members as possible

(C) Achieve a multilateral consensus on digital taxation in a timely manner

- Achieve a multilateral consensus to address the tax challenges arising from digitalisation in a timely manner
- > Long-term solutions should follow the principle of proportionality

1. Digital Transformation



(2) Promote international cooperation in the field of cybersecurity

➤ Develop/operate consistent or interoperable frameworks to <u>manage ICT</u> <u>risks along the entire global supply chain</u> and leverage voluntary global security standards

(3) Accelerate digital transformation throughout society

- Increase social adoption (i.e. increase digital literacy)
- > Facilitate widespread dissemination of digital technologies
- ➤ Establish and implement comprehensive E-Government, promote open data initiatives for public data

(4) Promote utilisation of trustworthy Al

➤ Establish holistic, human-centred, and future-oriented AI development and utilisation principles

(5) Launch real world projects

➤ Support the implementation of Society 5.0 by fostering cooperation among smart cities

2. Trade and Investment



- Renew G20 countries' commitment to the rules-based multilateral trade principles
- > Establish a common understanding of the effects and benefits of trade

(1) Reform the WTO

- A) Save and improve its dispute settlement function
- B) Improve its rule-making function
- Recognising that multilateral solutions based on consensus remain the ultimate goal, <u>members willing to move ahead to new rules</u> <u>through more flexible approaches must not be obstructed</u>
- ➤ Members should be encouraged to undertake commitments reflecting economic realities and capabilities
- C) Improve its monitoring function
- D) Institutionalise a multi-stakeholder consultation mechanism

2. Trade and Investment



(2) Strengthen international rules

(A) Ensure a level playing field

- Industrial subsidies inconsistent with WTO rules to be improved should be eliminated, and no entity should gain privileged access to non-commercially available benefits based on its ownership
- Expect the Global Forum on Steel Excess Capacity (GFSEC) to continue the spirit of "Global challenge, collective response"

(B) Protect intellectual property

- > Technology transfer should be based on commercial consideration
- (C) Improve market access in goods and services
- (D) Avoid fragmentation of financial markets
- (E) Support MSME's integration into global value chains

2. Trade and Investment



(3) Establish comprehensive and high-standard FTAs

> FTAs should not incorporate pre-emptive clauses nor quantitative restrictions, which are not in line with WTO rules

(4) Promote cross-border investment

➤ Establish open, non-discriminatory, transparent and predictable conditions for investment

(5) Improve international regulatory cooperation

Business for All

1. B20 Business Voluntary Action Plan

- (1) Respect human rights
- (2) Initiate proactive and voluntary measures to realise Society 5.0 for SDGs
- (3) Integrate SDGs into corporate strategies
- (4) Engage in fair and free competition, appropriate transactions and procurement
- (5) Maximise employees' potential capabilities and foster Diversity & Inclusion solutions
- (6) Integrate environmental and economic priorities
- (7) Act as responsible social actors and maintain a close dialogue
- (8) Integrate appropriate risk management frameworks and crisis management processes

2. Enhance communication with relevant stakeholders as appropriate

- (1) Disclose relevant corporate information fairly, effectively, and proactively in a transparent manner
- (2) Engage in constructive dialogue with shareholders and investors
- (3) Proactively communicate with a broad range of stakeholders

G20貿易・デジタル経済大臣会合閣僚声明抜粋 (2019年6月9日: 於つくば市)

- 44. International trade is important for productivity, innovation, job creation and development. We recognize the contributions that the WTO has made to this end. We agree that action is necessary to improve the functioning of the WTO. We recognize our business community's call for the G20 to continue supporting the multilateral trading system.
- 51. We take note of the "B20 Tokyo Summit Joint Recommendations: Society 5.0 for SDGs" as a voice of the business sector, while recognizing different national views on these proposals.
- 52. We also take note of the adoption by **the B20** of a **"Business Voluntary Action Plan"** which reflects views from the private sector and the intention of global businesses to strengthen efforts to jointly contribute to achieving the Sustainable Development Goals, through responsible business conduct.

G20大阪サミットに関する中西会長コメント

2019年6月29日/一般社団法人日本経済団体連合会

- わが国が初めて議長国を務めたG20大阪サミットが成功裏に終了した。米中貿易摩擦や地政学的緊張など世界経済の下方リスクへの対処とSDGsを中心とした地球規模課題の解決に向けた貢献が求められる中、経団連が推進し、本年3月のB20東京サミットでも賛同を得たSociety 5.0を実現するという方向性が共有されたことは大きな成果である。参加各国の発展段階や経済体制も異なる中、サミット議長として共通点・一致点を見出し、「大阪宣言」(首脳宣言)を取りまとめられた安倍総理の力強いリーダーシップに深い敬意を表したい。
- 各政策分野についても、「自由で公平かつ無差別で、透明性があり、予測可能で安定的な貿易及び投資環境」の実現、WTO改革の推進、信頼性のある自由なデータ流通、イノベーションを軸とした環境と経済の好循環、質の高いインフラ投資の促進に向けた原則など、B20の提言が広範かつ具体的な形で首脳宣言に反映されており、高く評価できる。
- これらを含め、首脳宣言に盛り込まれた課題は、いずれも一朝一夕で解決できるものではない。今後は、今回のサミットで得られた政治的モメンタムをベースに、8月のフランス・ビアリッツでのG7サミットでさらに突っ込んだ議論を行うとともに、来年のG7/G20サミットにおいても進捗状況を確認する等、具体的な行動・成果に繋げていくことが重要である。
- 経団連は、来週、フランスのエクス=アン=プロヴァンスで開催されるB7サミットに参加して議論をさらに深めるとともに、B20議長団体として、来年のサウジアラビアでのB20サミットの開催に協力していく。
